SMF riders can start only with the relevant national or one-event SMF licence. The riders from other countries will be asked to present themselves with the licence of their national federation together with the valid starting permission.

Driving fuel will not be secured in the paddock. The nearest petrol station: OMV, Slovnaft, Shel (1 km).

## INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider or passenger is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements. Giving a signature of a rider on the technical card, the rider confirms that he is insured against any accident, death, etc.

## PROTEST AND APPEALS

Protest against results, rider or motorcycle entered, must be presented to the Clerk of the Course within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results on the board. All protests must be made in accordance with the requirement of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code of the UEM, SMF and FIM and must be accompanied by a fee of 35,-- €, returnable if the protest is justified.

## OTHER

**Environmental directions:** Washing of the motorcycle in the area is forbidden. Pouring or throwing away used oil or any other petrolic waste outside the marked boxes is forbidden. The rider and his team have to use the environmental mat (2x1 m) by parking, repair works, refuelling. The rider and his assistance have to respect the silent hours – 22.00 – 6.00. It is forbidden to damage flora and fauna.

These directions are mandatory and are in conformity with the NR SR law nu. 543/2002 ZZ. Any infractions of these rules may be penalised - € 33,--.

**Start positions:** will be determined by the results of timed practices.

**Assistance:** is permitted: by furnishing assistance to the rider who fell off to lift him or his motorcycle up or by dismantling the motorcycle off the track. In the class JUNIOR the assistance is permitted by starting or mashing the motorcycle – distance max. 10 m. It is not permitted to mash the motorcycle over the finish line.

**Rider Apparel and Motorcycle:** must be in conformity with the supermoto technical rules of FIM and SMF. Infractions of these rules will be disqualification.

**Starting numbers:** design, size, number and the type of the number plates must be in conformity with the SMF technical rules:

Colours:

Class PRESTIGE (S1 450-750cc)	white background	black numbers
Class S3 (Open)	red background	white numbers
Class SENIOR	black background	white numbers
Class JUNIOR	black background	white numbers
Class HOBBY	white background	red numbers

The colours of the number plates and numbers must be matt.

## **TRAINING**

**17.07.2010 (Saturday) – all day € 25,--**

The paddock will be open from 16.07.2010 (Friday) 10.00 h.

Interpretation of these regulations rests entirely with the Jury.

The organiser has the right to change the time schedule in the case, there will be more than 20 riders in class. In the case of bad weather conditions, which could cause any danger to the participants, the organiser has the right to cancel or postpone the date of the event.
