



Principle for the 2020 SuperEnduro Fim Europe Cup (update at 5/9/2019)

- 1) Organisers interested in running a round of the FIME SuperEnduro Cup must make application under the normal FIME procedure.
- 2) FimFIMESE Cup: riders can be entered with appropriate license and starting permission;
- 3) FIME SE Cup is done by minimum 2 and max. 3 races;
- 4) Entries must be sent by ABC platform (100€+ 6€) total 106 €, 106€ +20€ if entry sent last two weeks, including costs of bank transferring.
- 5) Format: The format and prize giving for FIME Super Enduro Cup events is the responsibility of the Promoter and/or Organiser.
- 6) 2018 and 2019 SE FIME Cup winners will get a WILD CARD or place in GRADING LIST for FIME SE 2020. The winners of the previous two FIME SE Cup editions cannot start at the FIMESE Cup 2020.
Riders that scored more than 10 points in the previous SE World Champ. past years (2018 and 2019) can't take part at SE European Cup.
- 7) After closing the riders entries (via the ABC platform), the organizers will invoice to ABC the amount of the total FIMESE Cup riders entries (only entry fees). ABC will pay invoice.
- 8) The organizer is responsible for any FIME application fee's
- 9) One official appointed by FIME is in charge of the FIME Cup, no FMN delegates are admitted at the Race Direction Meetings.
- 10) Riders must have yellow color background on the plastic parts holder the machine numbers. Sticker numbers (or completed table with numbers) are provided by the organizer.
