#### 3. ACCESS

From Bajina Basta town You have to go with main road to Kaludjerske bare place on mountain Tara. Race office is in hotel Planinska kuca Tara.

# 4. INFORMATION ABOUT THE TRACK

The race track totals an estimated 200km of offroad terrain and is structured as follows:

- Day 1 (AAEE qualification) Prologue + Enduro, 60km estimated;
- Day 2 (AAEE qualification) Hard Enduro, 90km estimated;
- Day 3 (AAEE Race) Extreme Enduro, 50km estimated.

Day 1, Day 2 and Day 3 of racing will have a maximum time for completion which will be announced by the Organizer at the briefing.

Competitors who are still on the race track after the maximum allowed time is up will advance to the next checkpoint where they will follow the instructions given by the Organizer.

If the rider doesn't finish the Day 1, he can ride Day 2 but will start after riders who finished Day 1. Same is applied if a rider doesn't finish the Day 2, he can start on Day 3.

## **5. NEAREST HOSPITAL**

Nearest hospital is in Bajina Basta, 15km from the race camp. Other one is in Uzice town, 50km from the race centar.

### 9. INSURANCE, ENTRIES AND STARTING PERMISSIONS

All riders must be authorized by their national federation (FMN) in order to participate in the event(s) via starting permission plus license confirmation (to be presented at the administrative control). All entries must be sent minimum 2 days before the beginning of the Administrative control. All riders will be required to sign additional documents at the Administrative control. Riders under the age of 18 (minors) must be accompanied by a legal representative (parent or guardian) at the technical and Administrative control.

By singing and stamping the Starting permission for a rider, their FMN declares that the rider in question:

- has a valid insurance for motorcycling sports according to FIM Europe requirements,
- has no bans or prohibitions that prevent them to participate in the event,
- is physically and mentally fit to participate in the event,
- has the sporting skills of the required level in order to participate in the event without endangering him or other participants during the event

The organizers disclaim all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

The organizers have contracted a third party insurance according the AAEE regulations for the days of the event (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) for the amount of 180 000 euro.

### 10. ENTRY FEE

If paid until 01.06.2018. 23:59 hours local time, the individual registration fee is as follows:

- 70 EUR for female riders
- 140 EUR for the riders who ride all 3 days
- 90 EUR for the riders who ride 2 days
- 160 EUR if the registration fee is paid after 01.06.2018. 00:00 hours local time, regardless of gender, age or previous participation(s).
- NOTE: Bank fee is rider expense.

## 11. RANKING

Prolog is starting possition for Day1. Day1 + Day2 is total qualification time for day 3 (Race day). Result from Race day is final result.

If someone does not ride Prolog, Day 1, Day 2, that rider will get the worst time of rider who ride that day.

Total Time = Time (Race day)
