Circuit on a track with a uniform asphalt surface (karting circuit).

8. ENTRIES:

Registration for the event must be done by the 14.7.2026 at: <https://encross.sk/>. Entries received after the deadline will be charged extra €20 per class. If a rider cannot attend the event for which they have submitted an entry, they are obliged to inform the organizer no later than 24 hours before the start of the event. If they fail to do so, the organizer will require a fee of €20 for each case of unexcused absence. Riders may only participate in the race with a valid license of the respective federation, FIM, FIME, and foreign riders also with a start permission.

9. ENTRY FEES:

The entry fee for the race is €120 and will be payable at the venue. Riders registered after the deadline of 14.7.2026 will pay an entry fee of €140.

A rider competing in two classes pays the entry fee for the second class with a 50% discount.

The entry fee is paid during the administrative control according to the timetable, which is part of these supplementary regulations.

Practice on the circuit is available on Friday 17.7.2026 from 09:00 to 17:05 (with a lunch break) for a fee of €60.

A half-day practice (3 sessions): €40.

10. EVENT:

The event will take place in accordance with the 2026 SMF National Sporting Regulations (NŠP) for road racing and these supplementary regulations, which have been duly checked and approved by the authorizing body.

11. CIRCUIT INSPECTION:

The circuit inspection will be done on Friday (17.7.2026) at 7:45 AM by the Jury members, the Clerk of the Course, and the Chief Organizer. After the track inspection, a meeting with the organizer will be held in the presence of the officials involved in the track inspection.

12. ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS:

Washing of the motorcycle is permitted only in the designated area – without any chemical substances.

Pouring or throwing away used oil or any other petrol waste outside the marked boxes is forbidden.

The rider and his team must use the environmental mat (2x1 m) while parking, repair works, refuelling and under the waste boxes. The environmental mat must be made of an absorbent part (upper part) and an impermeable part (bottom part). Canisters with oil and petrol and their throats must be set out of the sunlight on the environmental mat.

All participants must respect the quiet time from 22:00 till 6:00 and secure their motorbikes and other valuables against damage and theft.

In the whole event area, it is forbidden to damage flora and fauna.

These directions are mandatory and are in conformity with the NR SR law number 543/2002 ZZ.

Any infractions of these rules may be financially penalized by 333 €.



13. MOTORCYCLES AND EQUIPMENT:

Every rider is obliged to use the equipment prescribed by the FIM and the SMF Technical Commission.

They must comply with the provisions of the national technical rules (NTP) valid for the 2026 season. Violation of these rules means the exclusion of the competitor from the event.

14. INSURANCE:

By signing at the technical control at the sporting event, the rider confirms that he/she is insured against personal accident by an insurance policy covering death, permanent disability and foreign riders also medical treatment and repatriation.

15. ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL CONTROL:

Venue: race secretariat and technical control stand. See the attached timetable. During the administrative control, the organizer will also require the identity card of the rider or the identity card of his/her legal guardian. Foreign riders must submit also a start permission issued by their FMN. No rider or machine is allowed onto the track during the race day without passing administrative and technical control.

16. RIDERS' BRIEFING - OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD:

The riders' briefing will be held according to the timetable at the starting area. The starting procedure will be demonstrated after the briefing. The briefing must be attended by: the Jury President, Jury members, Clerk of the Course, Chief Track Marshal, timekeeping representative, and all race participants. During this meeting, matters concerning the track and safety will be discussed. It is the responsibility of each rider and team to attend this meeting to receive all information and instructions issued. The information provided at this meeting is official, and the consequences of the absence of individual riders and teams resulting from a potential lack of information will not be considered later. The Jury is not obliged to duplicate the delivery of this information in other ways, e.g. by radio announcement or individual information in the paddock. An official organizer's notice board will be placed in the paddock area to announce all official information.

17. NOTICE:

During the event, participants under 18 years of age are prohibited from riding scooters, electric scooters, bicycles, mopeds, roller skates, etc., in the paddock. Non-compliance will be fined by €30.

18. TRANSPONDERS:

The distribution of transponders will take place next to the technical control area after fulfilling the administrative and technical verification. Transponders will be issued against a personal identity document. The mounting of the transponder is performed on the front fork in a vertical position (with the clip up). The rider is responsible for the correct attachment of the transponder. In case, rider does not have a transpondere holder, he/she is obliged to purchase one. In the event of loss of the transponder or failure to return it after the event, the rider is obliged to pay an amount of €500. If they fail to do so, their license will be withheld until this amount is paid. The Jury President is obliged to send the withheld license together with the materials from the event within 48 hours to the SMF secretariat.



19. PRACTICE:

It is strictly forbidden to ride on the race track outside the practice scheduled in the timetable. The exact schedule by categories and classes will be posted at the venue on the notice board. Free and timed practice will be according to the timetable. To qualify for the race, a rider must complete at least 3 laps during the official qualifying practices. The Jury reserves the right to merge classes.

20. GRID POSITIONS:

In individual classes, grid positions will be determined according to the time achieved in the timed practices.

21. RACES:

The races of each class are run as two separate point-scoring heats. The Jury reserves the right to merge classes. The evaluation and announcement of the winners will be carried out up to the third place based on the sum of points from both races. In case of a tie, the overall classification is decided by the better score in the second race.

The races of individual classes will be run for the following length:

- Yamaha PW 50, Babetta Cup / Jawa 50 Cup, Minimoto 110, Junior GP 110: 10 laps
- JuniorGP 160, GP2 Junior, Senior GP 160 / 190, Pitbike Junior / Supermoto Junior, Pitbike Senior / Supermoto Senior: 12 laps

22. OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE:

Outside assistance on the track is prohibited unless performed by a marshal designated by the organizer, who performs their duty in the interest of safety and may help start the motorcycle. The penalty for violating this rule is exclusion from the heat. An exception to this guideline may be granted by the Jury in the PW50, Minibike Junior A / B, Minimoto 110, and Pitbike Junior / Supermoto Junior classes, and only if safety measures are respected (e.g., sturdy footwear, reflective elements).

23. PARC FERMÉ:

After crossing the finish line, riders continue on the track, complete the lap, and ride into the paddock. After the second race, all riders will park their machines in Parc Fermé, where they will leave them for up to 30 minutes for the purpose of lodging a potential protest.

24. PRIZES:

The organizer is obliged to perform an official prize giving ceremony and decorate the first three riders in all classes. Financial compensation for placements will not be paid.

25. FUEL:

The organizer does not provide fuel; competitors can purchase it at the nearest gas station. The fuel must comply with the valid NTP for the 2026 season.

26. PROTESTS:

All protests against a competing rider or motorcycle must be signed only by a directly involved person and submitted to the Clerk of the Course no later than 30 minutes after the publication of the provisional results on the notice board. Each protest may concern only one subject. All protests must be submitted in accordance with the disciplinary regulations of the SMF and accompanied by a deposit of €200, which will be returned if the protest is justified.



27. CHANGES TO THE TIMETABLE:

The Jury reserves the right to change the timetable. In the event of bad weather conditions that could seriously endanger the health or life of the participants, the Jury reserves the right to cancel the race or postpone it to another date.

28. INTERPRETATION OF SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:

The interpretation of these supplementary regulations belongs to the Jury.

29. CAMPING FEE:

A camping fee of €10 / day / rider will be payable at the administrative control.

30. MISCELLANEOUS:

Rider penalty for a jump start – 10 seconds.
